

DECISION
Application 2896
Section 19(2)(a) Commons Act 2006



To correct a mistake made by the commons registration authority

Background

Application 2896 was made on 12th February 2015 to correct an omission by the commons registration authority in making an entry concerning rights of pasture attached to land at Tremeer in the parish of St. Clether, Cornwall.

Summary of the effect of the application

Application 1039 made 27 June 1968 described the right of common in part 5 of the application as the right of pasturage for 7 bullocks or ponies or 35 sheep over register unit No's CL 186 (Davidstow Moor), CL 373 (Tremeer Down), CL 374 (Higher Napps Moor) and CL 375 (Lower Napps Moor).

When the entry was made in CL 186, at entry No.19, the right to include the option of grazing 7 ponies was omitted.

Application 2896 now seeks to remedy this omission so the rights entry is amended for the right to graze 7 head of cattle or 7 ponies or 35 sheep, as was the intention of the original application and the rights entries as recorded in CL 373, CL 374 and CL 375.

Representations

No representations were received supporting or objecting to the application.

Decision

The application is approved. The applicant has shown that the commons registration authority made an omission in making rights entry 19 of CL 186, and it is deemed both fair and just to correct the omission.
