



The Commons Act 2006

Section 19(2)(a): Proposal to correct a mistake made by the commons registration authority

Notice is hereby given that a Proposal has been made by Cornwall Council as Commons Registration Authority, concerning two parcels of land on the periphery of St. Breward Common, described below, and comprising approximately 0.153 hectares.

A summary of the effect of the proposal is as follows: the land was incorrectly registered as common land, when the applications for registration did not include the parcels of land identified. If the Proposal is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by removing the land from the register of common land.

Representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the proposal, and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and
