**A Proposal by Cornwall Council  
Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006  
Correction of the register of Common Land  
CL 129 – St. Cleer Downs  
Entry No. 101 – Rights attaching to land at Puckator Farm**



- 1 The Entry the subject of this Proposal:  
CL 129, Rights entry No. 101, column 4, by virtue of application 1652:  
"To graze 17 head of cattle or 17 ponies or **185** sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit."
- 2 Application 1652, part 5 (Description of the right of common):  
"The right of common of pasture on St. Cleer Down for 50 sheep and 30 cattle."
- 3 Rights entry No. 34, column 4:  
"To graze 30 head of cattle and 50 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit."
- 4 Rights entry No. 34 was deleted with reference to "entry No's 67, 86 and 101 below".
- 5 Rights entry No. 67 refers to grazing over multiple register units, which is not relevant to entry No. 101.
- 6 Rights entry No. 86  
"Commons Commissioners Decision (Reference 206/D/100-103)  
In pursuance of Section 6(2) of the Commons Registration Act 1965 and by the direction of the Commons Commissioner, the registrations at entry no's ... 34, ... became final with modification on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1979 as set out below."
- 7 For entry 101, see paragraph 1 above.
- 8 Extract of Commons Commissioners Notice of Final Disposal of Disputed Registration (206/D/100-103)  
"Entry No: 34                      Number of grazing units: 17  
Each grazing unit confers the right to graze 1 beast or 1 pony or 5 sheep."
- 9 Rights entry No. 101 should therefore be amended to read:  
"To graze 17 head of cattle or 17 ponies or **85** sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit." (17 x 5)
- 10 It is considered unfair on other commoners if the rights entry is not amended in accordance with the Commons Commissioners decision.
