Table 6: Trend in under 18 conception rates, Cornwall 1989-2012

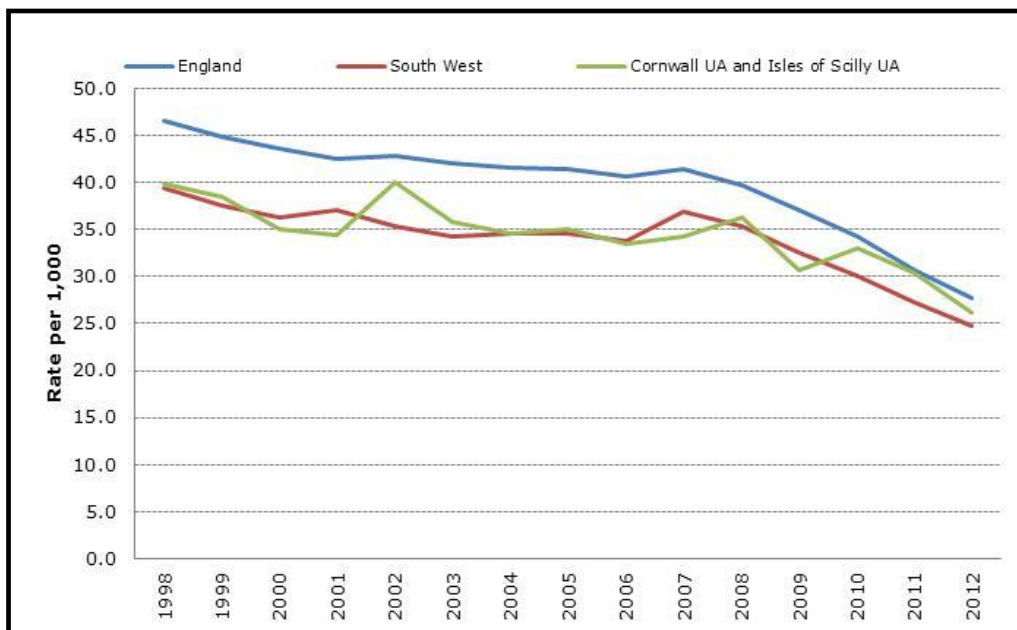

Age-standardised mortality rates are standardised to the 1976 European Standard Population, expressed per 100,000 population, they allow comparisons between populations with different age structures, including between males and females and over time. Age-standardised mortality rates (ASMRs) for Scotland and Northern Ireland will differ from those published by National Records of Scotland and Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency as their published ASMRs are based on only population data. ASMRs published here use live births instead of the population age under 1.
