Cornwall Infrastructure Needs Assessment

Camborne, Pool & Redruth Schedule



This schedule contains the infrastructure requirements for Camborne, Pool, Illogan and Redruth (CPIR) urban area as well as the requirements for the rest of the Camborne Pool and Redruth (CPR) Community Network Area.

Local Plan	<p>Council priority The CPIR area is one of two priority areas identified in the Core Strategy for regeneration. CPIR is one of the two former industrial heartlands of the Cornish economy and identified in the Core Strategy as a key transformational area.</p> <p>Core Strategy In the Camborne, Pool and Redruth Community Network Area the Core Strategy seeks to continue to focus investment in the urban area to underpin economic regeneration. It also seeks to address the need for housing and jobs throughout the CNA.</p> <p>Core Strategy key objectives for the Camborne, Pool, Redruth Community Network Area:</p> <p>5,200 homes in Camborne, Pool, Illogan and Redruth 1,000 homes elsewhere in the CNA, primarily to meet local needs.</p> <p>Development should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enable higher quality employment opportunities by sustaining and enhancing the area’s role as one of Cornwall’s primary employment hubs. • Deliver housing growth that will help facilitate the area’s economic aspirations, whilst also delivering much needed affordable housing for local residents. • Enhance the community network area’s retail offer, providing different but complementary roles for Camborne, Pool and Redruth. • Consolidate and enhance the community network area’s education opportunities • Reduce deprivation and support regeneration and growth through allocation of land for services, provision of infrastructure and through high quality design. • Deliver the highway and sustainable transport infrastructure needed to support the delivery of the area’s regeneration – including the eastwest link road and improved access into Redruth town centre. • Continue remediation of the area’s contaminated land • For CPIR to be renowned as a destination for cultural and heritage related tourism. 		
Town Framework	<p>A Town Framework plan for Camborne, Pool, Illogan and Redruth (CPIR) has been prepared by Cornwall Council to help inform and guide future development in Camborne, Pool, Illogan and Redruth over the next 20 years. The Framework has informed the Core Strategy approach to this urban area and the infrastructure needs for the area to ensure it meets the need for the existing and future population. In addition, the Redruth Action Plan as recently been approved by Council.</p>		
Costs	<p>The schedule identifies costs of the infrastructure projects where they are known. In many cases however the project costs are not known or are subject to change and caution is needed in regarding these costs. The total known costs of projects in the Camborne, Pool and Redruth CNA schedule are shown below but these come with a health warning as they are only temporary totals.</p> <p>Total known cost (many costs unknown at this time and some costs shared with other areas) for delivering the required projects in the area is :- £183,526,520.00</p>		
Funding	<p>As with costs, the information on funding as shown needs to be considered with caution, as new information on funding sources and figures emerges regularly. Cornwall has priority for the current wave of European structural funding through the Growth Programme and Cornwall Council has identified the CPIR area as one of two priority areas for strategic regeneration and investment. Public investment for infrastructure was backed by the European Regional Development Fund and has over the last 5 years topped £14 m, whilst further investment approximating £30 m is planned and proposed for infrastructure in the area. Further funding for infrastructure in the CPR area could come from the Cornwall Community Infrastructure Levy, New Homes Bonus, Regional Growth fund, Flood and Coastal Resilience Partnership Funding, etc.</p>
