

Dear Mr ,

I write in relation to your e-petition:

"Following the failed Truro Bus Lane, failed Lelant scheme, the scheme currently underway in Bodmin, and the recent announcement of a £3.5 million consultation on parking we demand that Mr Bert Biscoe resign or be made to stand down as Portfolio Holder for Transport. As taxpayers our money is being wasted without any consideration for the consequences and it must stop. Someone must take responsibility for these actions"

The petition has now closed and I am advised that it achieved 1,894 signatures although there are some duplicate subscriptions which should properly be excluded.

As the petition has fallen short of the 5,000 signatures required to trigger the possibility of a Council debate the Council is able to determine how the petition will be addressed, as provided in the Council's Petition Scheme.

The petition has been brought to the attention of Councillor Biscoe and the Leader, Councillor Pollard. It is not proposed that any other action is taken in response to the petition.
