Over 10.5 million pages to explore...

The **British Newspaper Archive** was launched in 2011 as a partnership between the British Library and family history website **Findmypast**, a complementary resource also available through JCS. Newspapers from the British Library's vast collection are scanned every day, producing digital copies that can be searched from anywhere in the world.

The online archive grows by more than 100,000 pages every month and currently includes:

- 870,000 newspapers from the Victorian period
- 56,000 newspapers printed during the First World War
- 41,000 newspapers printed during the Second World War

Publications from England, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

A treasure trove of information...

The **British Newspaper Archive** is fully searchable, so library members can enter the names of historical events, people, places or organisations and instantly find matching articles.

The results can then be refined by date, location or article type.

There's no limit to what you can discover. Historical newspapers contain a wide variety of information, including:

- Original reports about historical events
- Births, marriages, deaths and obituaries
- Local court reports and criminal trials
- Sports scores
- Advertisements
- Illustrations and cartoons
