

All about shoes...

Shoes are usually made from a mixture of leather, natural and synthetic rubber.

Parts of a shoe:

At Clarks the average pair of shoes has 60 individual pieces, plus the box, label and tissue paper that is gets transported in.

A basic shoe contains the following parts:

- Upper – the part of the shoe that surrounds your foot
- Inner – the lining of the shoe, usually made from leather or other breathable material
- Sole – the part of the shoe that you walk on. This is attached to the rest of the shoe by either stitching or glue.
- Laces (and eyelets) or Velcro
- Trims and labels
