If I walk 1 mile to school and 1 mile back from school, how far will I have travelled altogether?	2 miles
Which is the healthiest breakfast: A: cereal, yoghurt and fruit juice OR B: a piece of cake and a coke?	A: cereal, yoghurt and fruit juice
What is Walk on Wednesday? (Ask only if your school has this initiative)	When children try to walk to school every Wednesday
Which is the safest place to cross the road? A: On a zebra crossing, B: on a bend in the road, C: where there is a School Crossing Patrol?	A or C
What should you do if it is raining outside and you want to walk to school?	Take a coat, umbrella, wellies etc...
What could you do to reduce congestion around your school?	Walk to school, park and stride etc...
What is pollution?	Exhaust fumes from cars
If it takes me 10 minutes to walk to school and 10 minutes to walk home, how long will I have walked in one day?	20 minutes
My mum takes me to school with my little brother because we live so far away but on the way we pick up Johnny and Charlotte. How many people are there in the car?	5 (mum, me, brother, Johnny, Charlotte)
When I am going to cross the road and I listen, what am I listening for?	Cars, vehicles, cycle bells etc.
How many bikes can be parked in the space for one car? A: 2 B: 10 or C: 100	B: 10
I wear a bright yellow coat. I help children cross the road, I hold a sign that says 'STOP' on it. What am I?	The School Crossing Patrol/ lollipop lady/man

Questions	Answers
If I walk one mile to school every day of the week, how many miles will I have walked during the week?	5 miles
Why is it sometimes not safe to walk to school?	Answers will vary
What is 'car-sharing'?	When you share a lift to school with your family or friends
On Monday I walked to school, on Tuesday I cycled to school, on Wednesday I walked to school again and on Thursday and Friday I was driven to school. How many times did I walk to school this week?	2
Why is it good for you to exercise?	Because it burns energy/ it keeps your heart and muscles fit and healthy/ it's fun.
Some children in Cornwall travel to school by boat: True or False?	True (Flushing)
Do you use up more energy walking up hill or down hill?	Walking up hill
I have a bell, gears, 2 wheels and 1 seat. What am I?	A bike
We park at the local supermarket and then walk to school. Why do we do this?	It uses less fuel, we get exercise, it reduces congestion and pollution around the school.
Cars run on petrol/fuel. Will the amount of petrol in the world go on forever or will it eventually run out?	It will run out. (we are at peak oil which means we have used half of the world's supply already.)
Petrol is made from oil which is made from millions of tiny animals: True or False?	True
Which is greener? 10 cars taking 1 child each to school or one bus taking 10 children?	1 bus

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My school is 2 miles from my house. My mum drives me half the way and I cycle the other half. How far do I cycle to school?	1 mile
Should I walk along the road, the pavement or in people's front gardens?	The pavement
When I cross the road I always look both ways. What am I looking for?	Cars, vehicles, cyclists etc.
Is it better to walk in pairs or in single file?	It is better to walk in pairs and hold hands unless the pavement is too narrow.
What should you do if it is snowing outside and you want to walk to school?	Wrap up warm in boots, scarves, gloves and lots of woolly jumpers!
What do all the children in Cornwall do during walk to school week?	Walk to school as much as possible!
What should you always wear in a car to keep you safe?	A seatbelt
Who can help you cross the road?	School Crossing Patrol/ Lollipop lady/man
My Dad takes me to school in the car on his way to work. We pick up Matthew on the way. How many in the car?	3 (Dad, me and Matthew)
Name 5 things you might see on your walk to school?	Answers will vary
What is the smallest number of adults you need for a walking bus?	2: one at the front and one at the back
In a big city like London, is it quicker to get somewhere on your bike or in the car?	Bike. (An average 4 mile journey in London takes 22 minutes by bike and 40 minutes by car.)
