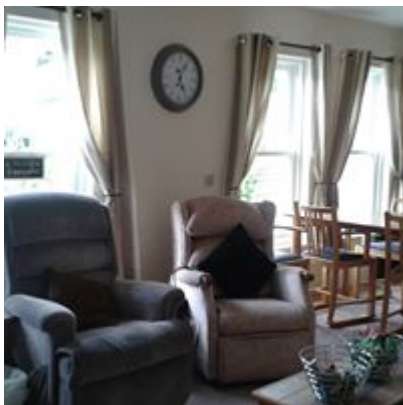


How much will it cost?

Cornwall Council will carry out a financial assessment to determine how much your contribution will be towards your stay.



How can you access Chy Koes?

People with a physical disability or their carers who are eligible to receive a service from Cornwall Council's Adult Care can ask for a Short break.

The length and frequency of short breaks will be agreed with your Social Worker, following an assessment. This may also include a visit to view our facilities. Once approved, someone from Chy Koes will contact you to discuss your needs and how these can be met during your short break.

What we offer:

Chy Koes is a 5-bedroom residential short break centre run by Cornwall Council.

We provide short breaks for adults, aged 18+, who have a physical disability and/or sensory loss and this is in a relaxed and friendly environment.



Fully trained staff are on duty 24 hours a day to assist you as required, and make your stay as enjoyable as possible. Your individual needs are catered for whilst maintaining your independence, privacy, choice and dignity.

The length of your stay can vary according to your needs and the availability of our rooms.

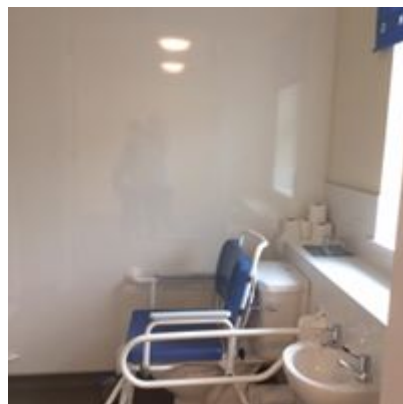
Our Facilities

The premises is a ground-floor unit centrally located within St Austell Town adjacent to the Tregarne Respite building
The building is modern and easy level access throughout.

We have 5 comfortably furnished single rooms all of which are ensuite.

Each room has a remote-control Freeview television and DVD player, together with a call bell system to alert staff.

Our lounge and dining room has Freeview television and a iPad you may use with the free Wi-Fi access in the building



Wi-Fi

Access outside leads to a level paved garden area, which is fully wheelchair accessible, with outside seating and tables. Whilst all areas inside the building are strictly non-smoking, smoking area for Service Users is provided

Meals

There is a fully equipped kitchen where all meals are prepared and cooked by our staff, using fresh healthy ingredients. Individual tastes and special diets are catered on prior arrangement and a set two weekly menu

Leisure

A selection of board games, books, jigsaws and Nintendo Wii are available. Visitors are always welcome and we are very happy for friends or relatives to take you out.
