Thank you for submitting your petition regarding the Trebarwith Strand Public Toilets.

As a result of cuts in the central government grant local authorities have been required to prioritise services and work differently to maintain local services. In relation to the provision of public toilets a decision was made to remove the budget and the Council were tasked with finding alternative local solutions, which allowed facilities to remain open.

The Trebarwith Strand toilets were transferred to the Parish Council who operated them during 2016 but the Parish made a decision to close the facility and hand them back to Cornwall Council as they were finding it difficult to maintain a funding stream through the charging. Following the transfer back of the toilets to Cornwall Council we have been working with the Local Member and others to try and secure the future provision of the toilets.

We are hopeful that over the next few weeks we can find a suitable solution which will see the toilets being reopened before the summer holidays.
