Both routes re-join at the Bodmin by-pass. From the outskirts of Newquay follow the signs to Fistral Beach, don't take the turning down to Fistral beach, carry on a few yards up the hill and you'll see us on the right hand side. Parking is available on site at The Atlantic Hotel.

Travel down the M5 to the end of the motorway at Junction 31, where you can choose the A30 or the more southerly A38 (which has some single carriageway sections and traverses the Tamar Bridge at Plymouth). Both routes re-join the A30 at the Bodmin by-pass. Use the left lane to take the slip road to Redruth/Porthtowan. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A3047. At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit and stay on. The next roundabout, take the 1st exit, On this final roundabout, take the 1st exit, follow Blowinghouse Hill to West End, the Hotels private avenue will be on your left.

You'll see signs for St Austell Enterprise Park, follow this road round to the left and head straight up into St Austell Business Park.

Both routes re-join the A30 at the Bodmin by-pass. At the Carland Cross junction head to Truro on A39, once in Truro keep following the A39 to Falmouth. Keep following the A39 till its end (Melvill Road), this is marked by a small roundabout close to Falmouth Docks Station, the Entrance to Falmouth Hotel is the 4th exit off this Roundabout.
