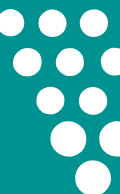
# Have your say on the latest changes to the **Cornwall Site Allocations Development Plan Document (Allocations DPD)**

## Hard words

Here are some words you may need help with.  
They will be colored **pink** and **bold**

---

### **Allocation**

Where an area of land has been selected for a certain use.  
It might for housing.

---

### **Infrastructure**

This is a word used to describe things like roads, schools,  
doctors surgeries, community halls.

---

### **Strike through**

This is when a line passes through a word so it looks like it  
is crossed out, like this ~~Strike through~~.

---

### **Consulted**

When we asked people what they think about something.

---

### **Planning Inspectors**

Planning experts employed by the Government to make  
sure things are done correctly.

**Schedule**

A list or timetable. In this case it's a list of changes to the document.

---

**Modifications**

When something is changed from the way it was before.

**Planning  
legislation**

Laws passed by Government about planning.

**Representation  
form**

This is the name of the form to use when you want to tell the Council what you think about the changes to the Cornwall Site Allocations Development Plan Document: Schedule of Proposed Modifications.

## What's happened so far?



The Cornwall Site Allocations Development Plan Document is a long title, so for now we're going to call it the CSADPD.



The CSADPD has already been **consulted** on many times in the past.



During the months of December 2017 and January to March 2018, **Planning Inspectors** examined the document so see if it was written correctly and meets **Planning legislation**.



When the **Inspectors** were looking at it, there were some changes that needed to be made. These changes are now in a document called the **Schedule** of Proposed **Modifications**.



Cornwall Council is now asking you what you think about the changes made to the CSADPD.



## How you can let us know what you think



The Council wants to know whether you agree with the **modifications** that have been made.



If you want to say whether you want to change anything, you can use a special form.

The words that have been deleted in the document are marked with a **strike through**.

**New words**

The new words to be used are in **bold**.



There is a special form on the Council's website called the **Representation Form**.
