EXEMPT AGRICULTURAL BUILDINGS

The term agriculture includes horticulture, fruit growing the growing of plants for seed and fish farming and includes greenhouses.

A building is considered to be agricultural if its primary use is for agriculture, or the keeping of animals providing;

- no part of it is used as a dwelling
- the building is at least one and a half times its height from a building which contains sleeping accommodation
- the maximum distance to a fire exit or point of escape from the building is 30m, and
- the building is not used for retailing, packing or exhibiting
