Voters in the new Bodmin St Mary's and St Leonard Electoral Division will continue to vote at St Marys Parish Centre (at two stations) while voters on the new developments to the west of the town that fall within the new Lanivet, Blisland and Bodmin St Lawrence Electoral Division will go to a new polling place possibly located within The Council Offices at Chy Trevail.

Overall turnout for the Bodmin St Mary's Electoral Division May 2017 – 28.5%

Overall turnout for the North Cornwall Parliamentary Constituency June 2017 – 74.2%

It is expected that this polling district will sit in the new Bodmin and St Austell Constituency, if the Parliamentary Constituencies (Amendment) Bill is enacted
