It is therefore proposed to divide it in order to create two smaller polling districts while retaining the current polling arrangements for voters. The two new polling districts will form part of the Bude Electoral Division in 2021
NBF1	BUDE-STRATTON - FLEXBURY AND POUGHILL 1	PARKHOUSE CENTRE	1767 (1449)	1811	This polling district will be divided as a result of boundary changes. It is proposed to create a single polling district for the part of Flexbury that will be within the Stratton, Kilkhampton and Morwenstow Electoral Division and another for the part that is within Bude Electoral Division. These changes also reflect the new warding arrangements for the Town Council. Polling arrangements will remain as now
NBF2	BUDE-STRATTON - FLEXBURY AND POUGHILL 2	POUGHILL VILLAGE HALL	500 (414)	511	No changes proposed. The polling district and polling station are unaltered by boundary changes. This polling district will form part of the Stratton, Kilkhampton and Morwenstow Electoral Division in 2021

Overall turnout for the Bude Electoral Division May 2017 – 42%

Overall turnout for the North Cornwall Parliamentary Constituency June 2017 – 74.2%

It is expected that these polling districts will sit in the new Bideford, Bude and Launceston Constituency, if the Parliamentary Constituencies (Amendment) Bill is enacted
