<b>1</b>	<p><b>Welcome, introductions and apologies</b></p> <p>Karen McHugh said she was sad to inform the delegates that this would be the last CNP Meeting for Anna Druce, Community Link Officer, as she is moving to the Newquay and St. Columb Community Network Area.</p> <p>Karen McHugh CC said that Anna has been invaluable to the Network, and everyone agreed. Everyone wished Anna good luck in her new post.</p> <p>Karen McHugh CC introduced Jacquie Rapier who will take over as the Community Link Officer in the Wadebridge and Padstow Network. Jacquie previously working in Cornwall Councils Democratic Services.</p>	
<b>2</b>	<p><b>Notes of the last meeting</b></p> <p>The notes where agreed.</p>	
<b>3</b>	<p><b>Devon &amp; Cornwall Police Update</b></p> <p>See attached report from Sergeant Sue Honeywell.</p> <p>A discussion regarding fake IDs took place and it was stated that there is a very active Pub Watch in operation in Wadebridge. If reoccurring incidents with regards to fake ID take place at premises, the Licensing conditions can be reviewed by the Licensing Officers.</p>	

	<p>Enforcing Alcohol Free Zones covered by Public Space Protection Orders (PSPO) is difficult.</p> <p><i>Action: The current signage within Wadebridge requires reviewing to ensure it is enforceable with the current legislation. JR to investigate.</i></p>	<p><b>JR</b></p>
<p><b>4</b></p>	<p><b>Strengthening Community Networks</b></p> <p>Cornwall Councillor Edwina Hannaford – Portfolio for Neighbourhoods, briefed the panel on progress made to date on the work to strengthen CNPs county wide and introduce the next round of initiatives.</p> <p>See attached presentation.</p> <p>The ‘Electoral Review Committee’ is due to meet on Tuesday 12 February 19, 10am to look at the boundary options. It is not a Boundary Commission review, the review is conducted by Cornwall Council. EH stated that her involvement is to be a Champion within the discussions and ensure the Parish/Town Councils voices a heard. Guidance notes with regards to the process will be available shortly.</p> <p>Richard Buscombe CC said that everything that can be devolved to the Parish Councils should be. There should be a willingness to devolve but not everyone at New County Hall is committed to it. There should be a proactive approach to devolution.</p> <p>Stephen Rushworth CC worth stated that Boundary Review suggests Cornwall Councillors decrease from 5 to 3, there won’t be the same synergy. He is concerned it will make it weaker not stronger.</p> <p>Networks will become the conduit between the Parish Councils, Cornwall Council and Services, such as the Police, Health etc. But there will be a need to devolve more budget to the Panels.</p> <p>Cllr Phil Mitchell believes Localism and devolution is working quite well over Cornwall but Parish/Town Councils have to be conscious what they take on. There is also a lack of Cornwall Council joined up thinking that lets the processes down, if the Council don’t embrace Localism, then it doesn’t work.</p>	

<p><b>5</b></p>	<p><b>Wadebridge Library</b></p> <p>CLlr Pennington from Wadebridge Town Council updated the panel on their learnings and future plans in relation to the recent transfer of the Library to the Town Council.</p> <p>See attached report.</p> <p><i>Action: Edwina Hannaford CC to forward email relating to the legal details of Parish Councils contributing financially in terms of devolution and keeping the libraries open.</i></p>
