3	Highways Scheme & Priorities in the Network	
	<p>All present at the meeting were asked to identify if they were attending as a voting Cornwall Councillor or the voting representative for a Parish Council.</p> <p>The voting members of the Panel are shown in the list of those present at the meeting (please see above).</p> <p>ER outlined the:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • current status of the CNP Highways Schemes Year 1 and their progress. • Highways Manager and Community Link Officer meetings that have taken place with the Town/Parish Council/Cornwall Councillors since March 2019. • Highways Scheme Process, which included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Schemes are submitted to CLO and Highways Manager - Highways Manager gives in principle comments on scheme and feedback is given on the submission if queries are raised - CNP prioritise the schemes and put forward a recommendation to Cornwall Council's Transportation Team and Portfolio Holder for Transport for sign off - Individual client briefs are written and sent to Cornwall Council for approval - Once approved, these are sent to Cormac's design and delivery team - Scheme proposals are then sent to local Cornwall Councillor for comment - Scheme is scheduled into programme of works with estimated delivery date (delivery can take 6-10 months) • Budget Summary <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2018-19 Year 1 schemes - Estimated costs £36,950 2019-20 Year 2 schemes - Estimated costs £76,656 <p>Each Parish representative gave a short presentation to the Panel members, explaining the reasons for the submission of their Expressions of interest (EOI). A summary of the schemes can be found in Appendix 1 below.</p> <p>At the end of all of the presentations, all voting members of the Panel were asked to indicate their preference for each EOI.</p>	

	<p>A query was raised regarding the differences in quotes for the different feasibility studies that had been put forward as EOIs. It was agreed that further information would be sought from Cormac on how the feasibility studies are costed.</p> <p>Cllr Mary May put forward a motion to vote all of the schemes through that had been submitted. This proposal was seconded by Cllr David Saunby. A majority vote agreed with this proposal.</p>	ER
