**Applications to vote by proxy** at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5.00pm** on **Wednesday 11 March 2020**, except in cases where **unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment** occurs after that time, in which case applications may be received by no later **5.00pm** on **Thursday 19 March 2020**.
