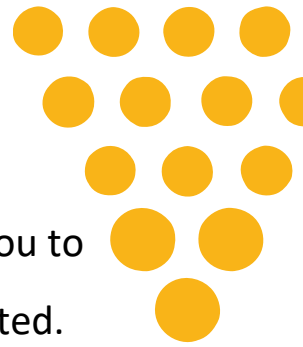


Paying for Adult Social Care and Support during the Covid-19 emergency



- You have been assessed as needing care and support to allow you to be discharged from hospital or to help prevent you being admitted.
- You will continue to pay assessed charges for any existing care and support you already have in place, but the Government will pay the cost of new or extended care you need during the COVID 19 emergency.
- However, you will need to pay the costs of new or extended care yourself when the government tell us the emergency period is over.
- You can apply for financial assistance with those costs.
- We will contact you by telephone to assess how much assistance you are entitled to. If you do not take part in the assessment, we will assume you will have to pay the full cost after the emergency has ended.
- We will tell you how much you will have to pay but will not start charging you until after the government tell us that the emergency is over.
