Community Network Priorities 2019/20

- i. Develop an economic strategy for the China Clay area as part of Cornwall Council's Place Shaping agenda.
- ii. Maximising grant funding opportunities from public and private sector sources including European structural funding and Community Led Local Development funding.
- iii. Infrastructure and public transport improvements.
- iv. Equitable delivery of services in the China Clay Area by Cornwall Council, police, health services and other public bodies.
- v. Working with partners to reduce the lorry movements in built up residential areas.
- vi. A review of gypsy and traveller policy with specific reference to mid Cornwall.
- vii. Extending the A391 link to A30
