



**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER
SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE & COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**(ADDITION OF A RESTRICTED BYWAY TOGETHER WITH THE UPGRADE OF FOOTPATH TO RESTRICTED BYWAY
AT TREWORGANS IN THE PARISH OF CUBERT) MODIFICATION ORDER 2021**

On 15 March 2022, Cornwall Council confirmed the above order made under section 53[(2)(b)] of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

i) Adding a length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of Cubert commencing at Unclassified Road U6086, approximately 26 metres south-east of “Treworgans Farm”, at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 7869/5887 shown as point “A” on the attached Order map, then running in a generally south-easterly then south-south-easterly direction for a distance of 111 metres to its junction with existing Public Footpath Number 10 Cubert to be upgraded to Restricted Byway by this Order approximately 134 metres south-east of “Treworgans Farm”, at OSGR SW 7875/5878 shown as point “B” on the attached Order map.

ii) Upgrading a length of existing Footpath Number 10 in the Parish of Cubert to a Restricted Byway commencing at a Restricted Byway to be added by this Order, approximately 134 metres south-east of “Treworgans Farm”, at OSGR SW 7875/5878 shown as point “B” on the attached Order map, then running in a generally south-south-easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres terminating at its junction with existing Public Footpath Number 10 Cubert approximately 145 metres south-east of “Treworgans Farm”, at OSGR SW 7876/5877 shown as point “C” on the attached Order map.

The order comes into force on the day that it is confirmed but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity on the ground that that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of Schedule 15 of the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under paragraph 12 (1) of Schedule 15 to the Act within six weeks from 23 March 2022, make application to the High Court.
