This Community Network Panel has worked well together over the years with the Highways Budget Scheme a good example of this.</p>	
<b>2.</b>	<p><b>Guest Speakers – Major projects in SE Cornwall</b></p> <p><u>Looe Parish Council – Mel Colton Dyer</u></p> <p>Please see attached presentation</p> <p>Sue Brownlow gave an overview of the Looe Development Trust Cycle Trails Project. Cornwall Council have now agreed to take on the Cycle Trails Project and develop the physical trails further. Any queries on this now need to be directed to Cornwall Council.</p> <p>The group have now moved on to looking at a new way of getting the community involved in sister project looking at heritage and culture, although plans have been delayed by</p>

<p><b>3.</b></p>	<p><b>Highways Scheme Update</b></p> <p>Paul Allen gave a quick update on progress of the highways scheme:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hoping that the TROs will be signed off within the next week then they will go to the Design Team. Work should commence on the ground in 2 to 3 months. There has been a slight delay due to COVID.</li> <li>• The West Street, Old Road Feasibility Study meeting has taken place with Councillors. It will be open for public consultation in the middle of February. This is a big scheme in the Highways Budget.</li> <li>• A further 12 schemes were agreed at the last Panel meeting in October and are being developed.</li> <li>• The East Taphouse Scheme has gone to SSE (electrical) to be installed.</li> <li>• Everything on the programme should be completed by March 2022.</li> </ul>	

	<p>Jane Pascoe CC asked if it would be possible to get the Liskeard consultation out before the schools go back.</p> <p>Paul Allen is due to retire in the next 2 months and William Glassup will be taking over the role. William knows the area and issues very well.</p> <p>Derris Watson thanked Paul Allen, from the Panel, for all the hard work he has done over the years.</p>	
<b>4.</b>	<p><b>Parish Council Feedback and Questions</b></p> <p><u>Dobwalls and Trewidland Parish Council - Mhairi Mackie</u></p> <p>The NDP Regulation 14 at Dobwalls is out for consultation and will end at the end of February. It is hoped to have an update at the next meeting.</p> <p>Open Reach is currently looking to update Broadband speed within the Liskeard Area.
