- Woodland Management and Improvement

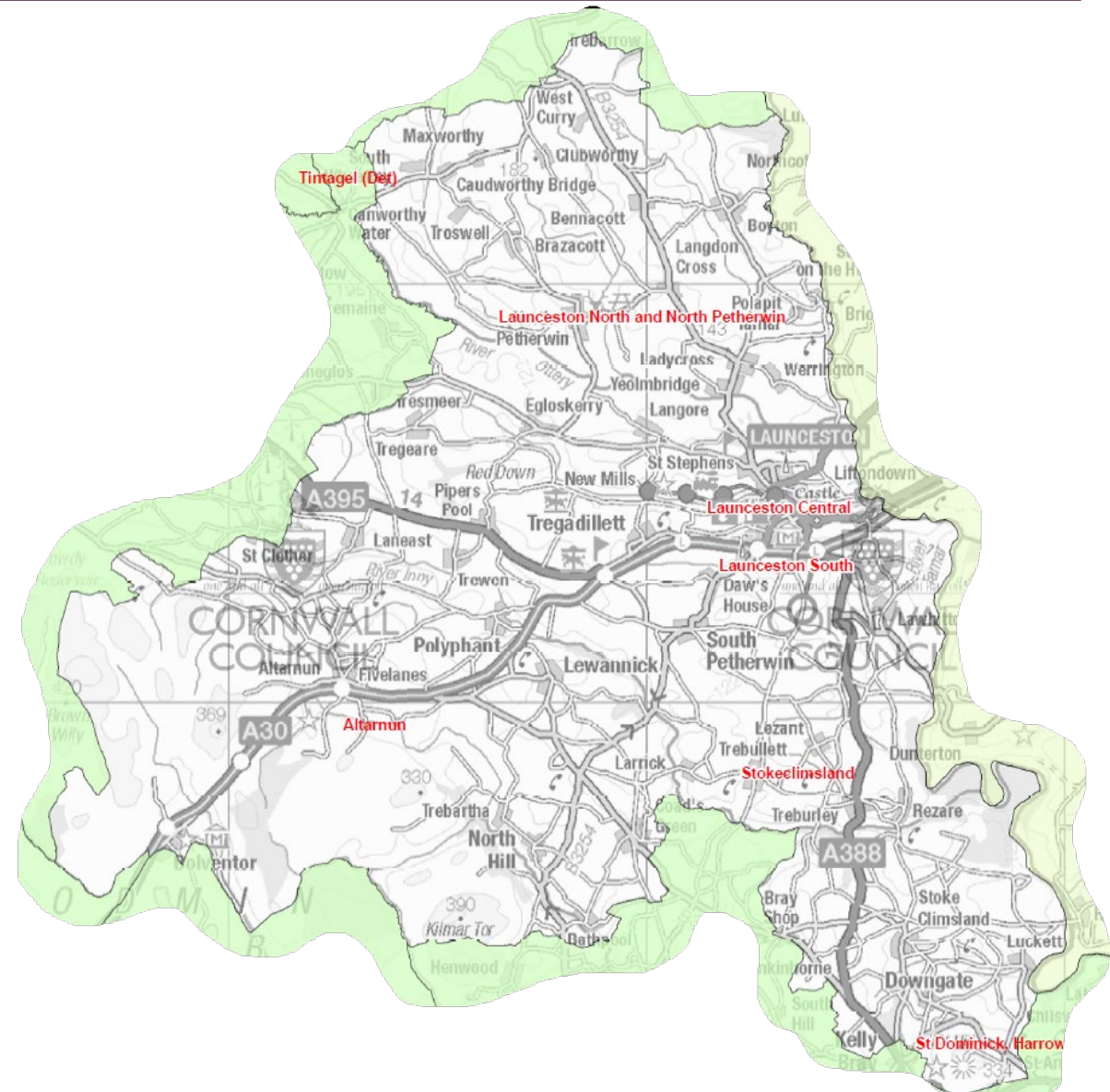

We want to invite the community into nature and engage people through planting and caring for trees

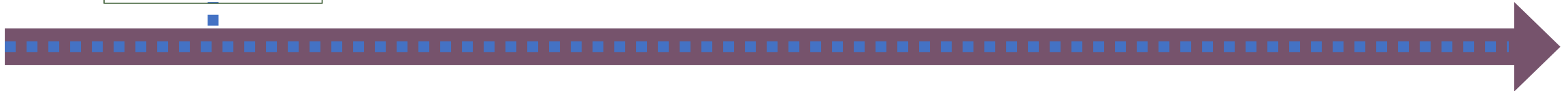
- Health & Wellbeing
