Opened in 1933, St. Anthony's Gardens are a delightful feature of Penzance, situated on the site of the 12th century St. Anthony's Chapel, the earliest Christian place of worship in Penzance. St. Anthony is the patron saint of fishermen.

The gardens contain an archway which was part of the original chapel, and a 12 foot fountain bowl, carved from a single block of granite.

- Mobile trading pitch within the area outlined red

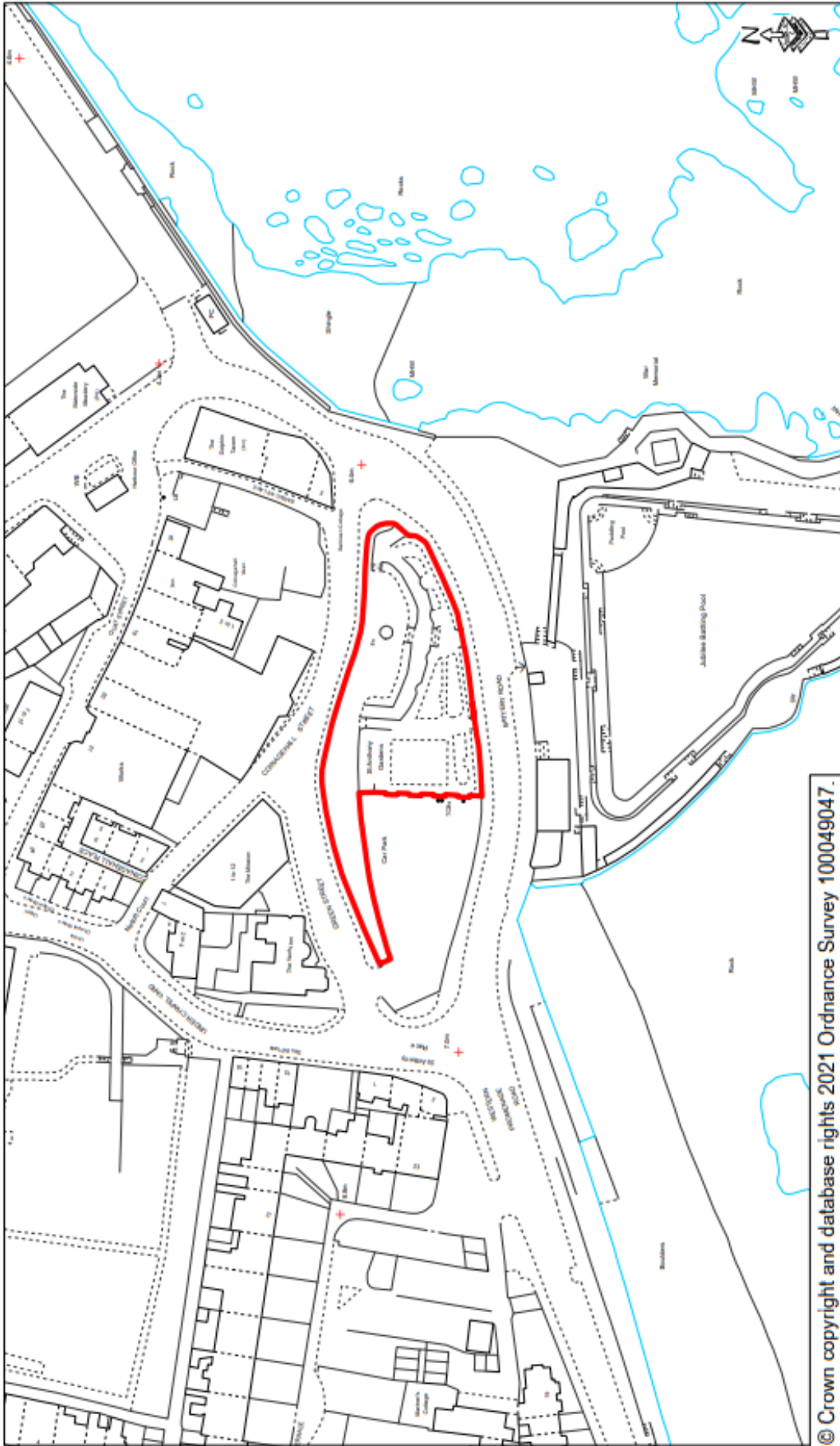
