Location

The Camel Trail is an 18 mile largely traffic free, surfaced and virtually level multi use trail used by around half a million people every year. It provides access to the beautiful Cornish countryside along a disused railway line between Wenfordbridge, Bodmin, Wadebridge and Padstow.

The trail is suitable for walkers, cyclists, horse-riders and wheel-chair users.

Description

- Concession area is 5m x 3m as marked in red on the plans. In a position that does not impede use of the Camel Trail; orientation of serving area away from main track.
- Suitable for the sale of ice creams, hot and cold drinks, snacks and other goods.

Site information

- Nationally recognised multi use trail from Padstow to Wadebridge.
- Access can be granted to the trail.
- The access to the trail must be maintained at all times for both the Cormac ranger and for Emergency Services.
- Local town very popular tourist destination.
- Congestion on the trail creating queues and blocking passage of users must be prevented.
