

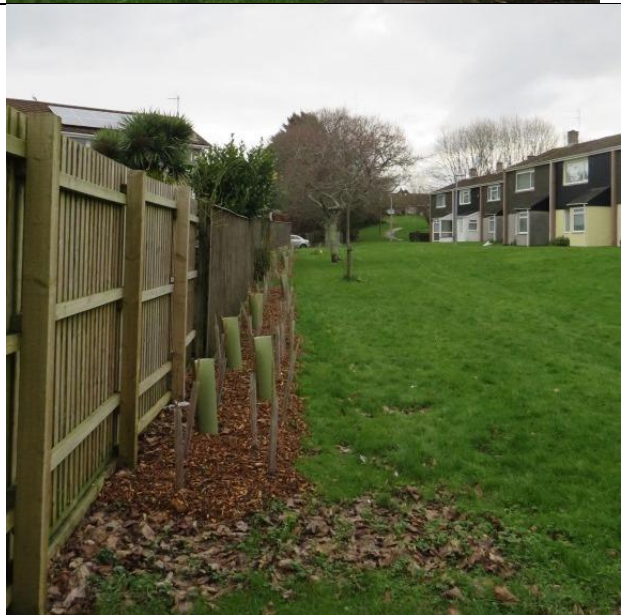


Green Infrastructure for Growth – Grenfell estate, Saltash –
January 2019

The Grenfell estate is a mid size estate with varied housing across its footprint. The open spaces in between the properties are typical mown grassed areas with little biodiversity interest.



A new hedge along the fenceline will provide nectar and refuge for wildlife over the coming years



New trees will complete a clear boundary for the estate to create a green corridor and sense of place
