SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE FORMER NORTH CORNWALL DISTRICT AREA

The Cornwall Council (Upgrade of Footpath to Restricted Byway at Poughill in the Parish of Bude-Stratton) Modification Order 2022

The above order made on 8th February 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading a length of existing Footpath Number 8 in the Parish of Bude-Stratton to Restricted Byway commencing at its junction with Unclassified Road U6192 approximately 23 metres south of 'Northcott Rise' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SS 2186/0817 shown as point 'A' on the attached Order map then continuing in a generally north-easterly then south-easterly then north-easterly direction for a distance of 352 metres to its junction with Footpath 9 Bude-Stratton at OSGR SS 2216/0827 shown as point 'B' on the attached Order map then continuing in a south-easterly then east-north-easterly direction for a distance of 283 metres to its junction with Footpath 10 Bude-Stratton at OSGR SS 2241/0823 shown as point 'C' on the attached Order map then continuing in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 300 metres terminating at its junction with the Classified Road C030 approximately 227 metres south east of 'Ashton Barn' at OSGR SS 2271/0824 shown as point 'D' on the attached Order map.

Any representation about or objection to the Order must be sent in writing to the Countryside Access Senior Natural Environment Records Officer, Cornwall Council, PO BOX 676, Threemilestone, Cornwall, TR1 9EQ (quoting Reference WCA 632) not later than 20th April 2022 stating the grounds on which they are made. If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, [or to any part of it], or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cornwall Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State [(or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981)] may itself confirm the order [(or that part of the order)]. If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State (in whole or in part) any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
